


Over six decades this commitment has become a lifestyle dedicated to great customer service and conservation of our natural resources.

Halley's Camps on the English River has evolved over the last 60 plus years, from the original barges at Kettle Falls, a summer tent camp at One Man Lake and an English River access point at Caribou Falls while the power dam was built. Our guests have come to know us as the family behind the quintessential Canadian fishing lodges and guest cabins that are the present day Kettle Falls Lodge, the year round luxury of One Man Lodge, the housekeeping cabins and new lodge at Caribou Falls Landing and the dozen remote, fly-in only outpost cabins scattered throughout the Canadian wilderness that we call our backyard.

After starting out as teenagers, at Caribou Falls Landing, Louis and Yvonne's son Gene and his wife Wanda now oversee the head office and air charter service in Minaki as well as the outpost cabins operating under the Outpost Company name. Their two sons have joined their parents in carrying on with the family tradition. Chris, his wife Amber and their family manage the camp at Caribou Falls Landing. Rob, his wife Bev and their children can be found looking after Kettle Falls Lodge.




Caribou Falls Landing

Among the seemingly endless expanse of lakes and forests, you will find Caribou Falls Landing, which has a long history of spoiling fishermen. The 100's miles of shoreline on the western side of the English River are as uninhabited today as they were before the first towns became established in Northwestern Ontario. Being the only outfitter on 35 miles of river, there are countless islands, underwater reefs, weedy bays, and 3 major tributaries: Werner, Winding, and Sturgeon Rivers. The waters are filled with walleye, northern pike, and smallmouth bass that have fishermen returning year after year.

Located 37 miles north of Minaki, Ontario, literally at the end of the road, Caribou Falls Landing has eight comfortable, modern housekeeping cabins and optional boat rentals. Chris and Amber will be your hosts at the Landing. Our lodge houses a small grocery store, souvenir shop, and bait and tackle shop. On-site we also sell fishing and hunting licenses, and gas.

In the lodge dining room guests can enjoy a hearty breakfast option, designed for those who just want to get out fishing. Also available in the lodge is free Wi-Fi internet.





The housekeeping cabins will accommodate parties of four to twelve people in either two, three, or four bedroom cabins with spacious living and kitchen facilities for your comfort, perfect for spreading out your fishing gear and planning the next day's fishing adventure. They are outfitted with electric stoves, refrigerators, and microwaves. You will have at your disposal a fully equipped kitchen and fresh, comfortable linens on box spring and mattress beds. Each cabin has its own deck that has a charcoal barbeque for your outdoor grilling pleasure and deck chairs for those who like to be the story tellers. All of the amenities at Caribou Falls Landing make it the perfect place for

relaxing in your own style on your own schedule!

We have a large fleet of boats available for rent. You can choose from a standard 18' Lund boat with 25 hp motors or our 18' Lund Alaskans customized by the Halley's with 50 hp motors.

We offer daily fly-outs to lakes that are only accessible by float planes. Be dropped off on your own secluded lake for the day fishing. Whether it'd be walleye, smallmouth, northern, trout or musky we have the species you wish to pursue. Reserve a date when you book or when you arrive, and let's go fly-out fishing!
